1. Bills Received / To Pay

All accounts have been paid and are up to date. \$290 outstanding fees for new pennant players.

3. Centre Improvement / Club Development Plans

New items for discussion

- Water Cooler - Current system is broken, not repairable. Tennis club have advised that it is not covered by the lease. We have quotes ranging from \$1000 - \$2000 to replace.

Possible long term goals for the centre (note current fundraising will not fund these projects):

- Upgrade the front walls - discussed that this needs around \$20,000 per court to convert to glass front walls, we don't really have any ideas on how to raise that much money. Steven suggested that this should be our long term goal for the club / centre.

4. Membership

We finished 2020 with 136 members.

Membership fees for 2021 will remain the same. We currently have 154 members including 32 junior members and 2 new ladies players, so we have achieved our goal of 150 for 2021. Well done to everyone!

Possible options to increase membership:

- Flyers to Murdoch Uni - discussed whether this could be a useful place to advertise squash, felt it was worth a shot. We will contact the university and see what options there are to advertise squash internally.
- Capture names and contact details of regular casuals and contact them about the benefits of membership etc - maybe offer some 'learn how to play squash' sessions to try and encourage adults to improve their squash. The introduction of the SquashLab app may assist with this process, as we will be able to communicate with people who have the app on their phone.
- Past players - actively follow up members who don't renew their membership, or past players, and encourage them to rejoin the club

5. Juniors

Commenced again in Term 2 2021. Runs from 4.00pm to 4.45pm (coaching), then through to 5.30pm for games, but may extend to 6.00pm if numbers increase again. Current numbers are around 30-40.

Tim Cowell is the Head Coach, and he is supported by Clare Slyth, Steve Newman, Anthony Campbell, Mark Gelman and Steven Jones. Thanks to everyone for volunteering their time. Further help is always welcome, so if you are interested in helping run the Junior Program, then please contact the committee or Clare Slyth

Funding allocated to Junior Program for equipment etc, estimated that we need to allocate \$1500 per year. This is currently being funded by \$500 from Kidsport, and all funds raised from the Containers for Change, around \$40 per month. Some equipment purchased already, current balance in Junior 'Fund' is around \$300.

Anthony Campbell and Mark Gelman have expressed an interest in completing the coaching course in July, suggest that the club fund the fees for this as both are supporting the junior program. Cost per person will be \$200 for coaching, and \$11 for Working with Children cards. If you know of any juniors who may be interested please point them in this direction.

The website has been useful for new players locating our club, with several enquiries being generated since it has been up and running. Aim to have one article posted onto the webpage each month, just to keep it active.

Website has been updated with current prices, recent photos, new sponsors and fundraising.

Articles - Need to get this up and running on an ongoing basis.

Hosting has been extended until 2022.

Facebook - this is our main space for sharing information. Posts need to be more regular and targeted. Strategies for this to be discussed further.

8. Newsletter

March newsletter has been sent out, next one due June 2021.

9. Pennant Teams

Autumn pennant about to end, two weeks to go, then finals. We have 11 teams this season - 3 x Monday Night, 8 x Tuesday night.

We also have a State League team running out of Blue Gum this season.

Next season will be moving to PAR scoring as a trial, but in reality it will be here to stay. Dates for next season still to be advised.

10. Grants

Mar 2021 - TAB Sports Grants - \$2000 towards equipment for the Junior program

Apr 2021 - Volunteer Grant (via Federal MP) - \$5000 requested for equipment, coaching courses, and furniture. Advised that approved for \$4,400, but waiting for confirmation from funding body before getting excited. Funding application was for coaching fees, new tables and chairs, training for the committee, junior equipment.
